talk shows, but it does happen. Divorce isn't *fun* under the best of circumstances. If you're dealing with the worst of circumstances, John Hollins is your man.

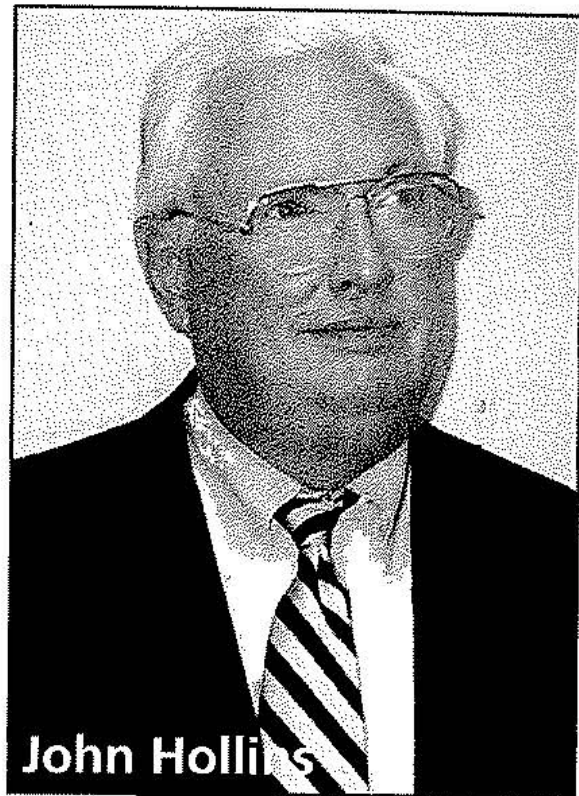
Before going into private practice, Hollins was a prosecutor in the district attorney's office for a number of years. Several attorneys cite that experience as giving him the hard-edged court-
